

MAGNETONS

The standard symbols in AIP publications are μ_{B} for the Bohr magneton, and μ_{N} for the nuclear magneton. (Note that nm now stands for nanometer.) They should be styled as symbols for quantities rather than as abbreviations for units—e.g. μ_{B} , $2.0\mu_{\text{B}}$, $(2.0 \pm 0.1)\mu_{\text{B}}$ (not $1\mu_{\text{B}}$, $2.0 \mu_{\text{B}}$, $2.0 \pm 0.1\mu_{\text{B}}$),
