

SAMPLE NUMBERS

A particular sample number should be used if it labels a special sample (or a sample from a special batch) that is unique and could not be reproduced with the same composition, and/or if the difference from other similar samples is important to the reader (for instance, in comparing data on the same sample from different references). The same applies if data concerning the particular sample have been stored and are going to be referred to. In such instances please explain the meaning of the letters (if any) preceding the sample number

If it does not matter what the number is, nor does it make a difference to the reader in papers other than the present one, numbering should be consecutive.
