

References in Physical Review A and Physical Review E

Since *Physical Review* is an archival journal, references that are published and available in the open literature are preferable to unpublished references. Information printed concerning unpublished references is therefore abbreviated. All references should be cited in text (in the body of the paper, not in the abstract), beginning with Reference[1], and numbered consecutively in order of appearance in text.

Styles for references printed in *Physical Review A* and *Physical Review E* are indicated below. Square brackets enclose information to be printed.

Theses: [Author], [degree], [Institution], [year].

Reports: [Author(s)], [Institution], Report No. [identification no.], [year], (unpublished).

Proceedings (unpublished): [Author(s)] (unpublished).

Proceedings (issued with a report no. by an institution): [Author(s)] in [Complete title], edited by [Editor(s)], [Institution] Report No. [identification no.], [year].

Proceedings (published): [Author(s)], in [Complete title], edited by [Editor(s)] ([Publisher], [City of publication], [year of publication]).

Journal articles that have been accepted for publication: [Author(s)], [Journal] (to be published). Additional information such as volume or year is not printed.

Journal articles (published): [Author(s)], [Journal] [vol. no.], [page no.] ([year]). Titles and ranges of page nos. are not printed.

Books that have been accepted for publication: [Author(s)], [Book title] ([Publisher], [City of publication], in press)

Books (published): [Author(s)], [Title] ([Publisher], [City of publication], [year of publication]).

Private communication: [Author] (private communication) Dates are not printed.

Manuscripts or preprints posted on electronic bulletin boards: [Author(s)], Report No. [identification no.]

References to the following would be printed [Author(s)] (unpublished).

- manuscripts or preprints not on electronic bulletin boards
- manuscripts submitted but not yet accepted for publication
- manuscripts in preparation or to be submitted
- lectures or invited talks
