

Electronic Author Status Inquiry System

Introduction

The Author Status Inquiry System allows authors of manuscripts under consideration by journals of the American Physical Society to obtain immediate information on the status of their papers electronically. All active manuscripts submitted to these journals (*Physical Review A-E*, *Physical Review Letters*, *Physical Review Special Topics–Accelerators and Beams*, *Physical Review Special Topics–Physics Education Research*, and *Reviews of Modern Physics*) are included.

This system is intended to serve better our authors and to reduce greatly the time our staff must devote to answering status inquiries by phone or email. The information supplied by the automatic system is drawn from the same database as used by those responding to such inquiries. In nearly all cases, the automatic system will supply at least as much information as has been available via phone or email query in the past; in most cases, MORE information will be available. Therefore, if you want to inquire regarding the status of your paper, **ALWAYS** first use the automatic system.

How to submit your search

To submit a search and obtain information about your paper, go to <http://authors.aps.org/STATUS/wvman1.html>. You need to know the accession code of your paper and the last name of any of the first three authors.

How to request clarification

If you have consulted the example at <http://authors.aps.org/STATUS/results.html> but still feel the need for further clarification of the information obtained from the automatic system, **DO NOT TELEPHONE**.

To request clarification, you may send an email message to prX@aps.org (where *X* denotes the journal considering the manuscript, *X* = a, b, c, d, e, l, stab or stper) or rmp@aps.org (for *Reviews of Modern Physics*); use as the subject line, for example:

Status LA1234 Jones

Responses to such queries will require human action, and should be expected within a few days. Please do not send such messages unless necessary, as that would defeat the purpose of the automatic system.

How to submit corrections or updates

In addition to showing information about the status of the review process, the automatic system will display other information from our database concerning the manuscript: title; authors; addresses (postal and email), phone, and FAX numbers of authors; journal section; PACS numbers. Authors are encouraged to check this information and as needed submit corrections through an email message to prX@aps.org with subject line, for example,

Correction LA1234 Jones

Implementing these corrections will require human action, and should be expected within a few days.

How to report technical problems

To report technical problems with the server (e.g., missing data or failure to respond), please send an email message to help@aps.org.

How to submit your comments and suggestions

We encourage general comments and suggestions regarding this system. You may send an email message to feedback@aps.org (do not use this address for communications regarding a specific manuscript). We will collect and review all comments, although we may not be able to acknowledge or respond to such messages. They will form a valuable basis for designing future upgrades to this service.

Status information about accepted papers

For papers that have been accepted for publication and sent to production, information about their status in the production process is provided by the production vendor. To obtain this information, submit a request to our Author Status Inquiry System (ASIS) and follow the link which appears on the results page.
