A signed APS **copyright-transfer** form (effective only on acceptance for publication) must be provided; the form is available on our Web server and appears at the end of the 11 December 2000 issue of *Physical Review Letters*. To help defray editorial and production expenses, authors of published Letters are requested to pay a **publication charge** of \$550 (\$200 for a Comment or Reply). Requested charges are lower (\$450 for a Letter, \$155 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REVTeX (preferred), LaTeX, Harvmac, Plain TeX; PostScript figures. Reprints are offered for sale to authors.
