Submission is a representation that the manuscript has not been published previously and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Authors should provide indexing codes according to the PACS scheme available at <http://publish.aps.org/PACS/>. A signed APS **copyright-transfer** form (effective only on acceptance for publication) must be provided; the form is available on our Web server and appears at the end of the 3 December 2001 issue of *Physical Review Letters*. To help defray editorial and production expenses, authors of published Letters are requested to pay a **publication charge** of \$595 (\$215 for a Comment or Reply). Requested charges are lower (\$485 for a Letter, \$170 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REVTeX (preferred), LaTeX, Harvmac, Plain TeX; PostScript figures. **Reprints** are offered for sale to authors.
