Rules pertaining to allowed length and memos regarding production requirements appear at the end of some issues of the Journal.

Manuscripts may be submitted electronically if in appropriate format (see <http://publish.aps.org/ESUB/> or inquire at prltex@aps.org). Alternatively, send four copies to the Editorial Office. Submission is a representation that the manuscript has not been published previously and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Authors should provide indexing codes according to the PACS scheme (available at <http://publish.aps.org/PACS/>). A signed APS copyright-transfer form (effective only on acceptance for publication) must be provided; the form is available on our Web server and appears at the end of the 16 December 2002 issue of *Physical Review Letters*. To help defray editorial and production expenses, authors of published Letters are requested to pay a publication charge of \$615 (\$220 for a Comment or Reply). Requested charges are lower (\$500 for a Letter, \$175 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REVTeX (preferred), L^AT_EX, Harvmac, plain TeX, MS Word; PostScript figures. Reprints are offered for sale to authors.
