Charges are lower (\$605 for a Letter, \$215 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REVTEX (preferred), Later, plain TeX, MS Word; PostScript figures (preferred). Reprints are offered for sale to authors.
