Authors should provide indexing codes according to the PACS scheme (available on our Web server, via ftp to aps.org in the /pub/pacs directory, and in print from the Editorial Office). A signed APS copyright-transfer form (effective only on acceptance for publication) must be provided; the form is available on our Web server and appears at the end of the 11 December 2000 issue of Physical Review Letters. To help defray editorial and production expenses, authors of published Letters are requested to pay a **publication charge** of \$550 (\$200 for a Comment or Reply). Requested charges are lower (\$450 for a Letter, \$155 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REVTeX (preferred), LaTeX, Harvmac, Plain TeX; PostScript figures. Reprints are offered for sale to authors.
