Instructions for manuscript preparation are given in the Information for Contributors published in the first issue of each volume and available on our Web server. Rules pertaining to allowed length and memos regarding production requirements appear at the end of some issues of the journal.

**Manuscripts** should be submitted electronically in acceptable format (see <http://authors.aps.org/ESUB/> or inquire at prltex@aps.org). If this is not possible, send one copy to the Editorial Office. Submission is a representation that the manuscript has not been published previously and is not currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Authors should provide indexing codes according to the PACS scheme (available at <http://publish.aps.org/PACS/>). An executed **APS copyright-transfer** form (effective only on acceptance for publication) must be provided; the form is available via our Web submission server and via <http://authors.aps.org/>. To help defray editorial and production expenses, authors of published Letters are expected to pay a **publication charge** of \$750 (\$275 for a Comment or Reply). Charges are lower (\$605 for a Letter, \$215 for a Comment or Reply) for properly prepared electronic submissions. Acceptable formats are REV $\TeX$  (preferred), L $\TeX$ , plain  $\TeX$ , MS Word; PostScript figures (preferred). **Reprints** are offered for sale to authors.
